Welcome to Worship at Immanuel

Morning Worship: Paul was a great missionary in the early church. This morning we will look at two of his success stories, a cloth merchant named Lydia and a nameless Roman prison guard. These two stories show the breadth of God's new people, but they also show great hospitality shown by the brand new followers of Jesus. We want to be encouraged about the growth of God's church even in the face of resistance and difficult circumstances.

Evening Worship: Pastor Kevin will lead us in studying some of the material between the stories we have been learning from on Sunday mornings. Tonight we'll look at the time between the meeting at Jerusalem (which we looked at last Sunday morning) and Paul's arrival in Philippi (which we looked at this morning). In these few verses, Acts 15:36-16:10, we find an argument, a recruitment, some false starts, and a dream giving clear direction. We'll wonder together about what is going on in the mind and heart of the great missionary as he walks through these experiences.
