Questions for Discussion Psalm 62

Why do the Psalms give us such words of comfort?

What is your favorite Psalm? Why is it your favorite?

Read vs. 1 & 2: In what ways has God provided your salvation?

Read vs. 3 & 4: In what situations has God shown himself to be your rock and fortress? What have been the “enemies” that have assaulted you?

Read vs. 5-8: These verses look ahead to God’s continuing care and protection. What hopes for the future are you clinging to at this difficult time?

Are there issues or items that challenge your trust in God?

Read vs. 9 & 10: Do these verses bring you comfort or stress? Why?

Read vs. 11 & 12: Our entire view of the world is shaped by whether or not we believe the truths presented here. How do you react to the statement that God is strong and loving? (Can you live confidently trusting this to be the case? Do you fight doubts? Do you have questions about how this can be in light of what we see in the world? Do you dare to say, “I will not be shaken”?)
