The Apostle Paul, as he explains the Gospel of Jesus, gives us some of the clearest insight into life after death. He assures that we have an eternal dwelling built by God.

Evening Worship: "We put no stumbling block in anyone's path, so that our ministry will not be discredited" (2 Corinthians 6:3). Paul was so concerned to protect his presentation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ that he would put up with anything to help the believers advance in their journey of faith. Paul's list of items to commend his ministry was quite impressive: hardships, beatings, imprisonments, riots, sleepless nights, and hunger. Paul shares this list to defend his claim that he has opened his heart with great affection for the Christians in Corinth. In working to restore the relationship he asks them to open their hearts to him in return. Here we have a powerful and personal example of relationships oriented to the reign of Jesus Christ.
