With her release from the horrific Nazi concentration camp only two years past, Corrie Ten Boom, a Dutch watchmaker, had gone to the homeland of her nation's fierce wartime enemy. There in Germany she was called to speak to gatherings of a still confused and yet contrite people. Corrie's Biblical messages often centered on forgiveness—a vital message of mercy that might bring reconciliation among people of such recent hostilities.

But the crucial test of Corrie's own heart came one night when she came face to face with a former prison guard, one who had worn the Nazi swastika in the very camp where the Ten Boom family had been imprisoned. Yet incredibly, after Corrie's passionate message, he warmly greeted this amazing woman who had spoken of Christ-like forgiveness. Here was a former soldier who had commandeered this Dutch woman and her family just two years earlier, viewing all such prisoners as little more than human trash. Remarkably, on this night in a German church basement, he gladly greeted Corrie as his true sister in Christ. A heart of cruelty had miraculously been transformed by the wonder of God's redeeming love.

Could Corrie's deep gratitude for God's mercy in her own life now be joyfully reflected toward a former adversary who had so brutalized her beloved family members? And is God's grace clear for the world to see in our commitment to forgive as we have been forgiven?
