Nehemiah 5:1-13

Vs. 1-5 The Situation:

Three-fold Complaint

Preventable Outcome

Vs. 6-11 The Teaching:

No U from F. – Deuteronomy 23:19-20

Do not charge your brother interest, whether on money or food or anything else that may earn interest. You may charge a foreigner interest, but not a brother Israelite, so that the LORD your God may bless you in everything you put your hand to in the land you are entering to possess.

Care for the L-F as F – Nehemiah 5:8

As far as possible, we have bought back our Jewish brothers who were sold to the Gentiles. Now you are selling your brothers, only for them to be sold back to us!" They kept quiet, because they could find nothing to say.

Vs. 12-13 The Learning:

"We will give it back," they said. "And we will not demand anything more from them. We will do as you say." ... At this the whole assembly said, "Amen," and praised the LORD. And the people did as they had promised.
