

River Stones

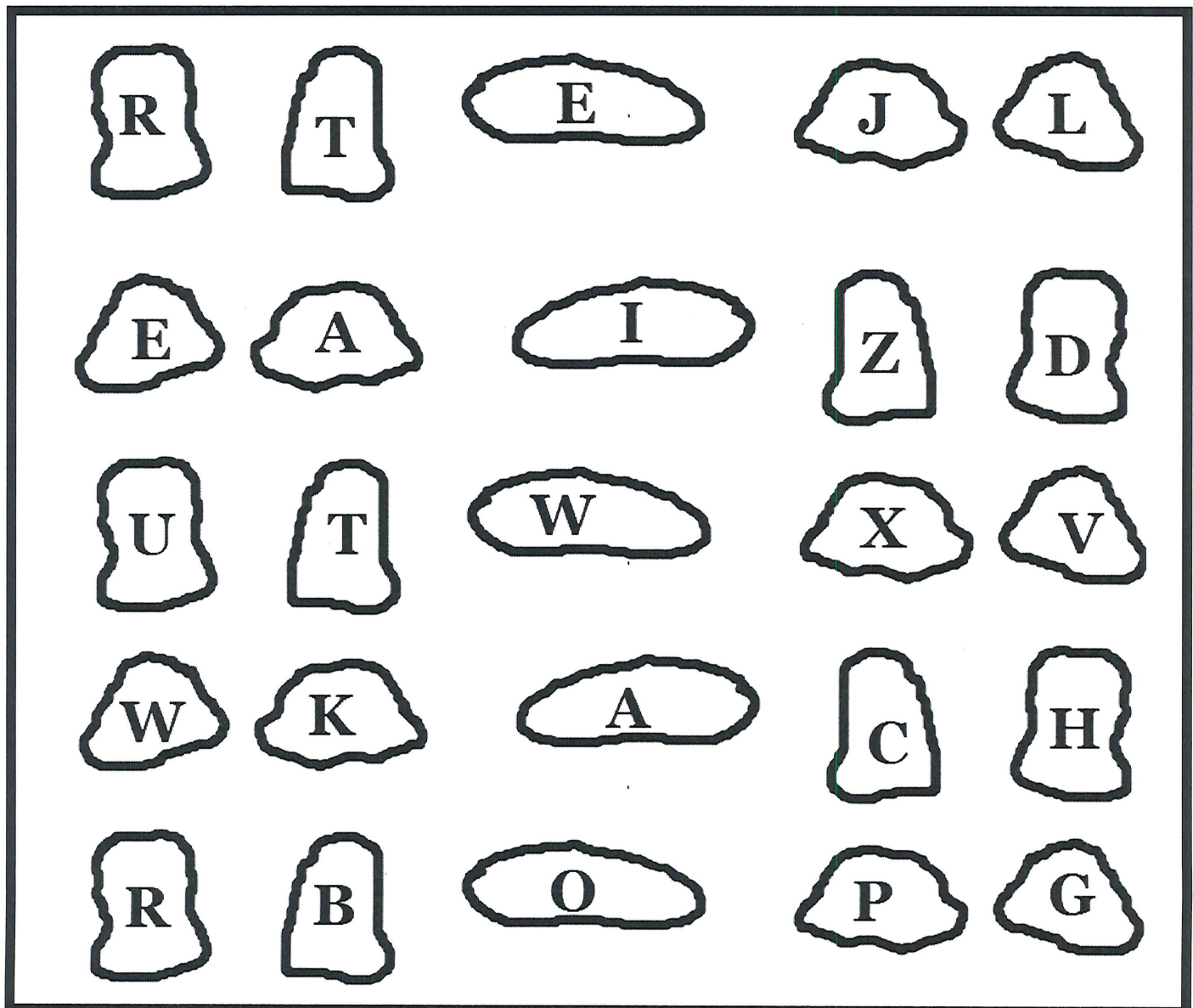
