Morning Worship: Godly leadership requires integrity and faith. This morning we find Joshua serving as one of twelve spies sent to reconnoiter land that the LORD has promised as a homeland for his people Israel. All twelve share the same experiences, but they report them to the rest of the people in very different ways. Two characteristics set Joshua and Caleb apart from the other ten: integrity and faith.

Evening Worship: Many of us find ourselves tired, burdened, and overworked. God deals with this all-to-human condition in his basic guidelines for living, the Ten Commandments. This evening we will look at the call to observe a Sabbath as God's gift of rest for his people. We all need rest, and one way God provides for that need is to set aside one day each week. God gave this gift to a bunch of people who were used to being worked as slaves. He offers it to us to relieve us from bondage to work and busyness. How shall we open that gift?
