Welcome to Worship at Immanuel

Morning Worship: Today we enter a unique season in worship called Advent where we look forward to the coming of Jesus. Often it is a time of recalling our longing for a Savior and for things to be set right. This year we certainly know that longing, so in our messages we are going to look at the arrival of Jesus from the perspectives of several witnesses. Today we will take the point of view of shepherds, simple folk who were privileged to receive the heavenly announcement of Jesus' birth and to greet the new born child.

Evening Worship: "Bone of my bone and flesh of my flesh." This is the joyful exclamation of the first man about the first woman. Genesis 2 presents the relationship of man and woman as that of complementary partners who through marriage can form a life-giving union. What does this foundational piece of Scripture have to say to our understanding of women and men today?

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Communion: This morning we proclaim our belief in salvation through faith in the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ through receiving the Lord's Supper. All who acknowledge Jesus as Savior and Lord and who have publicly proclaimed that through membership in a Christian church are invited to participate.
