Welcome to Worship at Immanuel

July 19, 2026

Morning Worship: This morning Pastor Kevin brings us back into our series on uncomfortable community. One of the big issues of the New Testament was whether or not non-Jews could become Christians without first becoming Jews; this was cemented by a dividing wall of prejudice between Jew and Gentile. In Ephesians, the Bible declares the truth that Jesus has broken down the dividing wall of hostility. Today, we are not segregated between Jew and Gentile, yet either/or issues still divide the church. What are our disputes and how does Jesus break down walls and make peace between groups?

Evening Worship: In Romans 11 the Apostle Paul continues asking a series of questions regarding how it has come to pass that so many of the Jewish people with all their advantages have not followed Jesus Christ. Tonight the question is, "Did God reject his people?" In answer to that Paul points to himself and to the time of Elijah when God "kept for himself" 7,000 people who did not worship idol gods. In his grace God has chosen and preserved a remnant among the Jewish people. This points to the great grace of God's electing love and should make us humble, prayerful, confident tellers of the Good News of Jesus Christ.
