3. Read vs. 25 & 26. How do these verses apply to our individual lives?

4. Considering that the “nows” of vs. 31 are speaking of Jesus’ impending death on the cross, what is meant by “Now is the time for judgment on this world?”

5. What is your personal application point from this passage?
