**Morning Worship: Teach Us to Want** – The 10 Commandments say, “Thou shalt not.” The Heidelberg Catechism expands those commandments to our thoughts and motives, and it explores the positive outcomes of fully keeping the commandments. “You shall not kill” becomes “Love our neighbors as ourselves, to be patient, peace-loving, gentle, merciful, and friendly toward them, to protect them from harm...” God's transformation of his people replaces hate, envy, and anger with self-giving love. Such an attitude adjustment requires also a readiness to forgive.

**Evening Worship:** Tonight, we will begin a short journey through the key teachings of the Great Reformation. “Scripture alone” as the only final authority for all matters of faith and practice was at the heart of the church coming to understand that salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. The final authority of the Bible is again under attack in the broader church. Differences surrounding this distinctive teaching are at the heart of many contemporary issues.
