Ice breaker: Tell a story of a time when you left things or people behind? What were you pursuing?

- 1. READ Luke 5:27-32. When it says Levi left everything, what was he leaving?
- 2. What have you left behind for the purpose of following Jesus?
- 3. Why did Levi throw this banquet?
- 4. How would you have felt in Levi's shoes? What might it have looked like for you to have a meal with Jesus that introduced him to your friends?
- 5. What implications does Levi throwing this party have for us in our rejoicing in Jesus?
- 6. Why does it matter in your own life that Jesus is willing and wants to eat and fellowship with sinners?
- 7. It is easy to look at the Pharisees and say (like a Pharisee in Luke 18:9-13), "I'm glad I'm not like that." Where are places that we might get hung up on religion to the point that we are missing God at work? **OR** How might our religious precaution get in the way of our rejoicing in Jesus and sharing the good news?
