Five Small Group Principles

FULLY DEVOTED DISCIPLES DESIRE TO BE IN AUTHENTIC RELATIONSHIP WITH
THEIR SMALL GROUP COMMUNITY. – Acts 2:42-47

DISCOVERY (TO KNOW AND BE KNOWN)

To have authentic relationship we must know one another deeply.¹

together.⁴
