Welcome to Worship at Immanuel

Why does God teach his people to submit to one another? How are we to practice submission today in a world that has seen so many abuses of dominance and submission? What if the flip side of submission was not dominance, but love? What does it mean for those remaining in Jerusalem? And, what does it mean for God's church today?
