Welcome to Worship at Immanuel

Morning Worship: Submit to one another. That word, “submit,” carries all kinds of emotions for us. Whether in work, school, or family relationships the journey of submission is often a bumpy road. Why does God teach his people to submit to one another? How are we to practice submission today in a world that has seen so many abuses of dominance and submission? What if the flip side of submission was not dominance, but love? This is what we see demonstrated by Jesus and what he calls us to imitate when we are instructed to “Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.”

Evening Worship: The Glory of the LORD led Israel through the wilderness; it settled into the temple when it was dedicated, but in Ezekiel 10 the glory of the LORD departs from the temple. The people of Israel and Judah have repeatedly demonstrated their unfaithfulness to bring thing to this point. What does this departure mean for the exiles in Babylon? What does it mean for those remaining in Jerusalem? And, what does it mean for God's church today?
